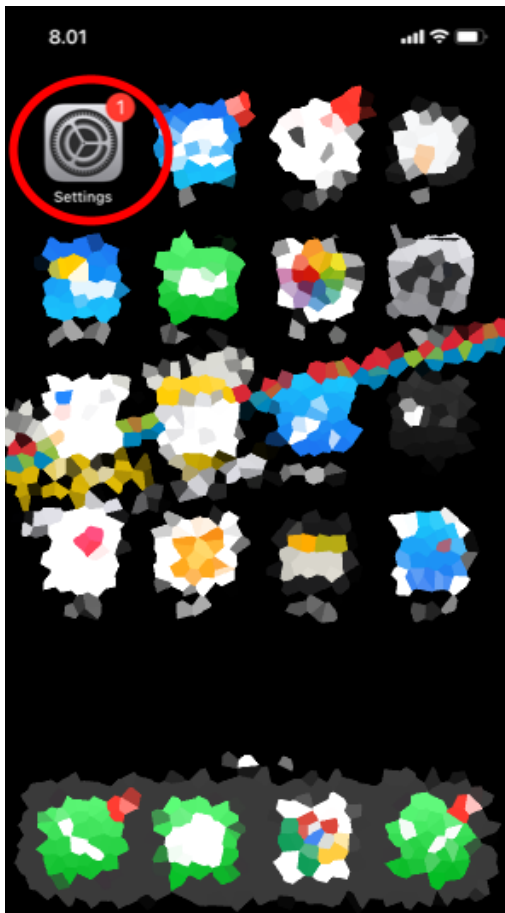
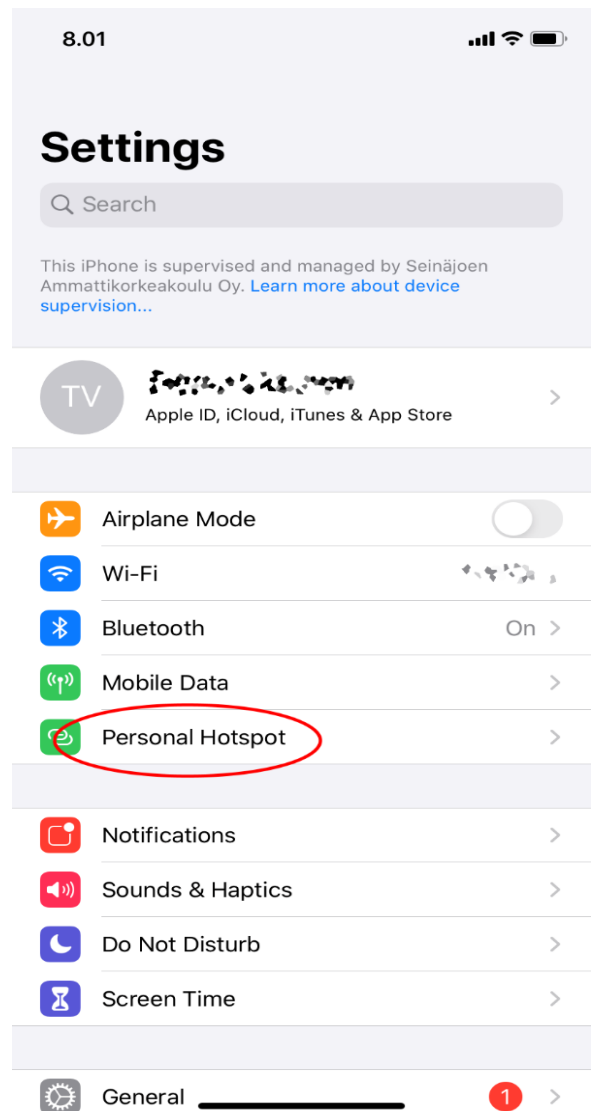


## Sharing data connection from an iPhone with a laptop

1. Open iPhone Settings



2. Open Personal Hotspot



### 3. Switch on Allow Others to Join



Below the switch you can see the password of your own Hotspot Wi-Fi. This is a randomly generated password that can be changed freely to make it more memorable but avoid using special characters and Scandic characters.

**NOTE** You must not leave the password slot empty

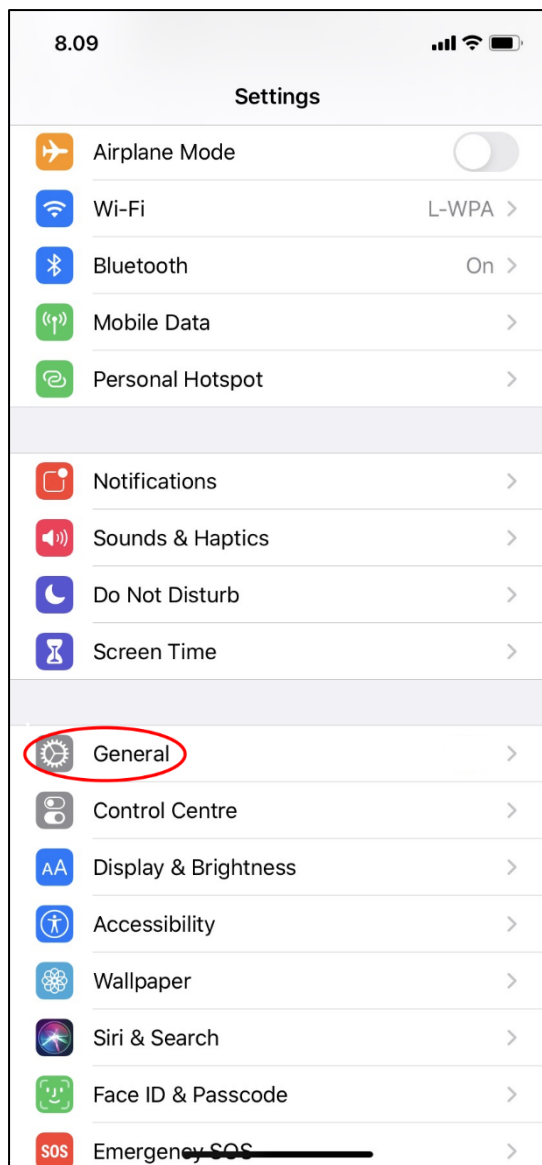
4. Your Hotspot Wi-Fi is now visible to other devices as a network that can be joined. After this the connection shared by the phone is shown in the list of the wireless networks of your computer. By clicking on this, you can start joining with the password that you can find in the phone.

Below you can find instructions how you can check the name of your Hotspot Wi-Fi network. In this case the network is iPhone.

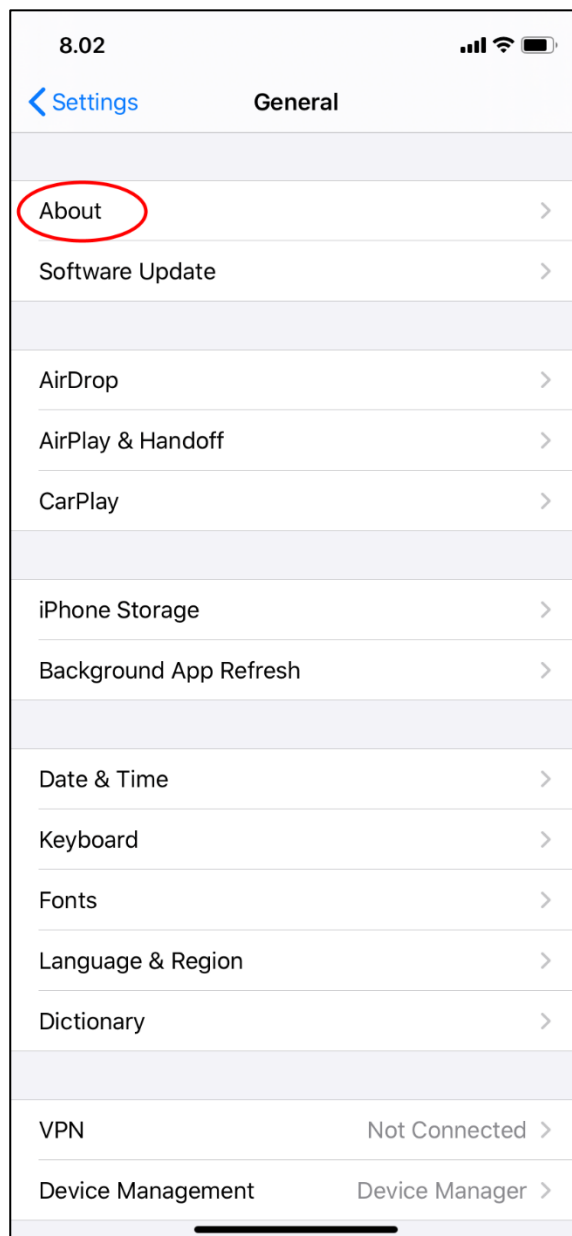


If you have problems with joining a Wi-Fi network, change the name of your Hotspot Wi-Fi. See instructions next page.

1. Open the General menu in Settings.



2. Open the About menu



3. At Name you can see the name of your Hotspot Wi-Fi (in this picture iPhone).

This name is shown in other devices as a Wi-Fi network. You can change the name of your Hotspot network by tapping on Name. Enter a new name and tap OK. Please avoid the use of Scandic characters both in the password and in the name your Wi-Fi network.
